The Intra Operative Monitoring (IOM) Specialist is responsible for the monitoring of the brain, spinal cord, and peripheral nervous system during neurosurgical and orthopedic procedures in concert with an existing monitoring team. The Specialist is directly accountable for clinical practice issues, monitoring personnel performance and ensuring that standards of practice are adhered to, monitored and up-dated through the development and implementation of clear guidelines and performance standards. Additional responsibilities include quality improvement and evaluation of service as well as teaching and research.

The successful candidate will have a level of education, training, and experience equivalent to a PhD and five (5) years recent, related experience in a complex health care environment including direct patient-related multimodality IOM experience. Registration with the American Association of Neurophysiology or Certification in Neurophysiologic Intraoperative Monitoring is preferred.
